Dr. Azmi's lecture on Focused Ultrasound — Last Monday, Dr. Hooman Azmi, a neurosurgeon from Hackensack University Medical Center, presented on the topic of MRI-Guided Focused Ultrasound, a relatively new procedure to treat tremors of the hand. The presentation and Q&A session was attended by approximately 35 people and the only location in New Jersey that it is offered is at Hackensack University Medical Center. The lecture was not taped, but Dr. Azmi offered that focused ultrasound has very little downside due to its non-invasive process. He said that the ultrasound forms a small lesion that interrupts the tremor, but only after repeated "trial" runs to ensure the accuracy of the process. Dr. Azmi further stated that the procedure works after just one treatment.
